

**BAGLEY TOWNSHIP SPRING CLEANUP
DROP OFF WILL BE SATURDAY, JUNE 7, 2025 FROM 7AM-11AM
AT GLF LOCATED ON M-32 IN ELMIRA**

BRING bagged trash, furniture, mattresses, sofas, tables, bikes, toys, sinks, toilets, etc., that are not waterlogged. Appliances, microwaves, hot water tanks, stoves, air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, *(Residents are responsible for having Freon removed by certified contractor and certification sticker MUST be affixed to the unit)*. Electronics, TV's, stereos, computers and components. Carpet, padding, and construction materials must be cut into 4 foot lengths or less and rolled and securely tied and must be dry and weighing no more than 50 lbs. All other items must be bagged, boxed or bundled and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

DO NOT BRING yard waste, tree limbs, leaves, compostable items, liquids including un-solidified paint, appliances with Freon, chemicals or hazardous wastes, flammables and explosives, broken glass, dangerous items, gasoline-propane tanks or ashes, motor oil, antifreeze, car batteries, transmissions, tires or railroad ties, concrete blocks or stones, wet carpeting, engine blocks or any item too heavy to be lifted by two people.

Driver's license and tax bill will be required at gate to prove residency.
Be in line by 11 am to drop materials.

COMPOSTING SERVICE

In cooperation with the City of Gaylord, Bagley Township provides a composting option for you. Bring your grass clippings and leaves to the City of Gaylord Department of Public Works (DPW) at 102 Seventh St.

It's important that the material is compostable. Do not bring tree limbs and branches or plastic lawn and leaf bags. The rich, black topsoil generated from this project is also freely available to Bagley Township residents.
